

PIONEER CREEK SENIOR LEAGUE GOLF GUIDELINES

2012

PC Senior League welcomes all members to what is expected to be a great **2012** season.

The MAIN emphasis of the PC Senior League is to have fun and enjoy yourself while playing a round of golf. We at Pioneer Creek Golf Course pride ourselves in a golf philosophy to tailor our games (tournament and non-tournament days alike) to the magic of competitive golf. In addition, the members of PC Senior League also respect the game of golf as it is meant to be played.....**by the rules**. With this idea in mind, we feel it is each member's responsibility to know the rules of golf and play by them. Rules of Golf handbooks are available in the Pro Shop.

Since golf is an contest sport, we gear our events to play either on an individual or team basis. Because golf is also a social game, we encourage a team spirit with several assorted **MIXER** events (See League Event Schedule).

The following items are what you need to know about our Senior League.

DUES:

Your dues of \$35.00 is allocated to the following.

1. Prize fund for Senior League events.
2. Scheduled Cookouts.
3. Administrative expenses.

HANDICAPS: Handinet \$15, USGA GHIN \$38.

All members **MUST** have a handicap service. Please contact a Senior League Official (Listed on Page 2) with any questions concerning handicaps. 2012 handicaps from other golf courses are transferable and accepted for league play. Your card is updated on the 1st and 15th of every month. **It is YOUR responsibility to enter all adjusted 18 hole or 9 hole scores played at Pioneer Creek Golf Course or a course observing an active season at the time of your round and inserted into the Pioneer Creek Golf Course system located in the pro shop.**

HANDICAP AND SCORECARD PROCEDURE:

Our handicap "Station" is located in the rear of the PC Pro Shop. There you will find our computer system for handicaps and a posting of a current list of all Senior League members handicaps. Also posted are index number conversions to PC handicap figures.

Your USGA Ghin handicap card can be used for play throughout the United States whereas the " Handinet" handicap card can only be used for tournament play at a limited number of golf courses in Minnesota . All Senior League competition is based on your officially listed handicap and **must be posted on your event scorecard**. You need to be aware of your USGA handicap index conversion number. Use the conversion number when posting a handicap on your scorecard.

EVENT PLAY GROUP SCOREKEEPER , PLEASE:

1. Print (clearly) both the first and last names of players in your group.
2. List a non-member Senior League player as "**GUEST**".
3. List a players handicap.
4. Post the **GROSS** score on the card and in the Pro Shop Computer for each Player in the Group
5. Deposit the finished scorecard in a box container located near the computer station.
6. Indicate in the computer which tee-box (White or Gold) each Player used.
7. List in the computer a players score as TOURNEMENT (T).

OTHER NOTES:

All Senior League events are played primarily from the White Tees. On rare occasions, a League event may be played from Yellow Tees. (That Yellow Tee Event will be posted well in advance of play and will be optional). The Senior League computer automatically records your round from either the "White Tees" or "Gold Tees". It's important your rounds are entered from the appropriate tees for calculating and listing a correct personal handicap.

TOURNAMENT PRIZES:

Those who place "in the money" in our League events are issued league prize money (Event Credit Chits). All event credits awarded during the golf season will be redeemable at the Pioneer Creek Golf Course Pro Shop for merchandise (current stock or catalog orders). The event results are available at the Clubhouse (on the bulletin board) within 6 days following the event. Results are also posted on the Pioneer Creek website (www.PioneerCreek.com)

REMINDER!!!!!!All Senior League tournament credit must be redeemed for merchandise on or before November 1st of the current year. NO CARRY OVER TO THE NEXT SEASON!!!!

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT:

- Thou shall abide by all USGA and local course rules.
- Thou shall be courteous to other players.
- Thou shall keep up with the group ahead and avoid SLOW PLAY.
- Thou shall not cheat.
- Thou shall refrain from club throwing and cart bashing.
- Thou shall avoid excessive and /or loud expletives.
- Thou shall post all scores both **home and away**.

Unbecoming conduct of a Senior League Member shall constitute grounds for suspension and/or dismissal from the League subject to review by the Senior League Board of Officials

MORE LEAGUE NOTES:

The League coordinator will provide for your enjoyment the following:

- Optional Net Skins (Two flights...0 to 18 & 19 to 36).....\$1.00.
- Senior Club Championship and 3 Mixer events as part of the overall play schedule.
- Extended League Play beyond the 22-event regular rounds (weather permitting) the event

EVENT SIGN-UP AND LEAGUE DAY PROCEDURE:

- You must sign-up on the sheets located on the bulletin board or phone pro shop for assistance. The tee time sheets are taken down the Monday night (8 o'clock) before the scheduled event.
- The tee time sheets for a scheduled event are posted on the bulletin board two-weeks prior to Senior League Event.
- If you forget to sign-up, you can call the pro shop. A club staff member on duty will try to get you on the tee sheet. If you have to cancel, please call the pro shop **(952.955.3982)** as soon as possible
